Itinerary:

- 7:30 a.m. meet at KLMS (back of school - by the band hall) load buses
- 8:00 a.m. Depart KLMS
- 11:30 a.m. Arrive at 6 flags
- 3:00 p.m. check in (chaperone area-check in with your bus roll check person)
- 5:45 p.m. Meet at chaperone area/load buses for roll check
- 9:30 p.m. Arrive at KLMS: please have ride waiting in the back of the school, by the band hall—parents: please don't park in the fire zones—leave room for the buses to pull in

****ATTENTION 8TH GRADERS: Remember; Algebra and/or Spanish (for high school credit), 'end of course exams' schedule will be modified:**

Algebra, Monday, June 1st (1st half during band class, 2nd half during Algebra class)

Spanish: Wednesday, June 3rd (written portion during band class, oral portion during Spanish class).

WHAT TO BRING

- A good attitude
- Instrument in its case, with name tag, and all music-(we will lock them under buses during the day)
- A sack lunch and/or snacks to eat on the bus before we get to the Contest (drinks must have a 'screw-on' lid)
- School appropriate clothes for the park, you may also want to bring a dry change of clothes for the ride home if you plan on riding the water-type rides (the buses are air conditioned and are chilly)
- Waterproof watch if you have one
- Comfortable walking shoes to wear in the park
- Sunglasses (bring a strap or purchase one there so you do not lose them)
- Money for supper (park food is expensive!—approximately \$10.00-\$12.00)
- A little extra money for souvenirs, snacks, etc. (optional)
- (extra money for special gifts for band directors.....just kidding!!)
- Pillow, blanket, small games, something to read, etc. for the bus trip
- You may bring an MP3 player/CD player (must have headphones) or a camera but there is always the chance that it will be lost or stolen at the park
- You may bring a mini DVD player-**BUT ALL movies must be rated G!!—(we will also have movies to watch on the bus video system)**
- Only bring what you can carry into the park (lockers are available for rental at the park)
You will NOT have access to the buses while in the park!!
- There will be a chaperone at the 'meeting area' (the 'Mexico' section) at all times if you need help
- Students need to pace themselves through the day, be sure to drink lots of WATER, and use sunscreen
- A light jacket for the evening (it can be cool at night this time of year in the metro-plex)
- In the case of inclement weather, we will meet at the chaperone check in area immediately and make a decision about what to do
- Students are expected to follow all appropriate band and school rules. *Any student not following the rules could be asked to call their parents to come pick them up, and will not be allowed to return with the band.*
